

SPECIAL MEETING


FEBRUARY 7, 1976


ANNUAL SETTELMENT MEETING

## ANNUAL TOWNSHIP MEETING

APRIL 3, 1976

The annual meeting of Conway Township was called to order by Supervisor Maurice Kingsley. Seventeen people, including Fred Dillingham, County Commissioner were present. Minutes of the last annual meeting was read and approved. Treasurer Sonja Klein gave the financial report for 1975-76 which showed an income of \$38,942.34 and expences of \$ 39,009.87 with a balance of \$969.34 at year end.

Time of holding the annual meeting was discussed. motion by George Robb seconded by George Fyrclak to continue holding annual meeting in the evening ~~in the evening~~ and to hold regular Board meetings on the third Tuesday of each month except March. motion carried. Supervisor Kingsley reported the need for a person to take dog census and care for the cemeterys.

The 1976-77 proposed budget was presented by the Clerk. Motion by Nona Fyrclak seconded by George Robb to accept the budget as presented. Motion Carried. Motion by George Robb seconded by Fred Klein to ask the Allotation Board for 1 mil Township tax for the comming year. Motion carried. Motion by George Robb seconded by Nona Fyrclak to keep Township general fund monnies in the Community State Bank. Motion carried. Motion by George Robb seconded by George Fyrclak to give the Township Board athority to raise and spend Township monnies with common sense. Motion carried.

Fred Dillingham, County Commissior reported on County Government problems which include office space, Judge and Court problems, and the County budget. Mr Dillingham reported that there would be two building proposisions on the May 18, ballot, one for the resoration of the Court House and one for the building of a new Law Building.

Meeting was adjurned by Supervisor Maurice Kingsley.

It was the feeling of the Board that with the limited funds the only way that improvements could be made was by modifying some of the specifications and doing a limited section at a time.

Supervisor Kingsley reported that Ken DeCamp was caring for the Miller cemetery. Motion by Voss seconded by Klein to pay \$20. per mowing at the cemetery. Motion carried. Motion by Klein seconded by Voss to send Mr. Williams a letter requesting a trailer permit, action to be taken in five days. Motion carried. Motion by Klein seconded by Voss to use Revenue Sharing for July to December for roads. Motion carried. Motion by Klein seconded by Dickerson to purchase a new voter registration binder. Motion carried. Treasurers report showed a balance of \$9487.54 as of April 30. Motion by Klein seconded by Voss to pay Bills. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned by Supervisor.





The question as to whether this road is a private or public road is not certain at this time. There are no Township records and the Livingston County Road Commission have no records to show the road to be public. The land owners involved have maintained the road for many years. Mr. Hoisington will do further checking into the matter. Mel Voss reported on the William Willshaw special use permit application. Motion by Klein seconded by Kreeger to issue Mr. Willshaw a permit subject to inspection by Mel Voss to ascertain if the fence meets requirements. Motion carried. Motion by Klein seconded by Kreeger to adopt a resolution to give support to building a new fire hall. Motion carried. Motion by Kreeger seconded by Klein to leave the Revenue Sharing account as it is. Motion carried. Fred Dillingham was present and discussed County problems including the possibility of changing the selection of Board of Road Commissioners from appointment to election at large. Motion by Dickerson seconded by Klein to go on record as in favor of continuing the system of the appointment of Road Commission members by the Board of County Commissioners. Motion carried. Motion by Klein seconded by Voss to charge a 1% collection fee for taxes collected by the Township Treasurer and to waive the 4% late payment fee for taxes paid after February 15. Motion carried. The Engineer from the Road Commission was present and presented new plans and cost estimates for the Sober Rd. construction, from Owosso to Marsh. After discussion of the plans for the east one mile and the east 1/2 mile, Sonja Klein moved and Mel Voss seconded the motion to table the question. Motion carried. Motion by Voss seconded by Klein to bond the Clerk and Treasurer for \$5,000. with Burnham & Flower Agency. Motion carried. Motion by Klein seconded by Voss to pay bills as presented. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned by the Supervisor. After the meeting the Clerk gave the oath of office to newly elected officers, Maurice Kingsley, Clerk Chester Dietrich, and Treasurer Sonja Klein.

Motion by Kreeger, seconded by Voss, the present members of the Zoning Board, ~~Raymond Johnson, Rowan Tussie & Joanne Mc~~, whose terms are to expire January 1, 1977, be reappointed. Motion carried. Nominations of Roger Pierson, Gary Raddatz and Henry Miller to fill vacancy on Zoning Board were presented. They will be contacted for willingness to accept and appointment will be made at January meeting.

Presentation of bills, created much discussion. Motion by Kreeger seconded by Klein to bond the Constable for \$5,000.00 with Burnham and Flower Agency. Motion carried.

Motion by Klein seconded by Kreeger, that \$10,500.00 be withdrawn from Conway Township Revenue Sharing Account to be applied towards the Road Commission Bill. Motion carried.

Motion by Kreeger, seconded by Voss to pay bills as presented. Motion carried.
