KEY FACTS


- More than \$18.7 million has been approved for 7,894 households.
- 14,501 home inspections have been completed.
- Disaster Survivor Assistance crews have visited more than 17,600 homes.
- Michigan homeowners and renters in Eaton, Ingham, Ionia, Kent, Livingston, Macomb, Monroe, Oakland and Wayne counties can apply for FEMA assistance.
- The deadline to apply for assistance is Monday, April 8, 2024.

KEY MESSAGES

- If you already made repairs or started your recovery, you can still apply. FEMA inspectors are trained to recognize damage caused by a disaster even after recovery has started.
- FEMA's assistance programs are designed to help you with basic, critical needs such as a safe, sanitary and accessible place to live. These programs are available to renters, including students.
- You don't have to be a U.S. citizen to apply for assistance. If a member of your household is a citizen, non-citizen national or a qualified alien, you can join their application for assistance. You can also apply on behalf of your child if they meet the eligibility criteria but you do not.
- Disaster Unemployment Assistance is available for those who lost work as a direct result of the August storms. Apply by March 27, 2024. <u>Download an</u> <u>application here</u>.
