Fowlerville Road utility poles are up to code regarding age of poles and neutrals. Utility poles sit more than 25 feet off the road and they would have to destroy crops to get to them. Big towers are now limited. New sites have to be added. Any Bell Oak number can now receive DSL 60 meg service. The orange area on the map is legacy old equipment and Freedom Net will not put more people on these towers. One problem with the newer equipment is that the signal bounces off trees. They are using licensed microwave. They have gigabit service on Lovejoy Road. 'Rain fade' due to rain or snow can occur now on wireless. Fiber would not help with the situation right now. The cost is \$60 charged by DTE to conduct an inspection to tell FreedomNet if a pole can support the internet. From Nicholson Road to Bell Oak is all upgraded to support aerial fiber optics. The cost is \$22,000 to bring fiber optic from Allen Road to the township working with Wow and FreedomNet. The goal within the next two years is to have 95% of the residents delivered broadband. From the towers to the customers is the gap. The cost is \$226,000 from Allen to Lovejoy Road due to infrastructure. Iosco Township cost to do fiber to the home is estimated at \$3.7 million which didn't include pole inspection (with a 50% take rate). 1. A Presentation was made by Mr. Chuck Madden about how Conway Township might be able to Add High Speed Internet by way of Fiber Optic Cable. He explained that there is a Fiber Optic line as far as the High School to the south and in Morrice to the north. He explained that the way Lapeer Intermediate School district did it, was on a 10 year Municipal Bond they installed their own cable and they own it. They paid the Bond off in 7 years. There are several steps that must be taken. Permission from DTE (there is a cost per pole (apx. \$4.72 cents per pole per year) to install on their poles, and permission to attach to an existing line, plus permits. There are old laws in place already dating back to when the U.S. become wired for electricity. Once the Line is run there are educational grants as well as grants under the Rural Farm act. He advised that we should try to partner with the neighboring townships on all 4 sides of us as well as Iosco township. Definitely include the County and the School. Mr. Madden advised that once the trunk line is installed then suppliers will come out of the wood work to make internet available for sale to residents and business.

A resident asked how we get started and Mr. Madden advised to start with a Feasibility Study. When we hire someone to do that study, his recommendation is to do it by the hour and recommends no more than 50 hours per township to start. 2.
